

A pupil or staff member is a close contact of a person with symptoms

You are notified by NHS Test and Trace or by school that your child has been a close contact of a positive case of COVID.

Your child has no symptoms

It is advised that close contacts should arrange a PCR test (if Test and Trace direct this then you must do so)

Pupils who have been identified as close contacts but who do not have symptoms should still attend school whilst awaiting PCR test results.

If parents keep pupils at home in these circumstances, this absence must be recorded as unauthorised.

Members in the same household of a Close Contact do not need to self-isolate.

Monitor your child closely for any symptoms of COVID.

If symptoms develop then follow the guidance on Symptoms/Positive LFD or PCR Flow Chart.

If your child is not symptomatic, then you may consider using daily Lateral Flow Tests whilst awaiting PCR results.
