

Year 1 Phonics

In Year 1 we have many sounds and words to learn (I have attached the list on the next page.) Tricky words are words that can't be spelt out phonetically but children will need to recognise them from sight and need to be able to spell them accurately in their writing.

At the end of Year 1 children will have a phonics screening test which is a test with 40 real and nonsense words. Children need accurately say 32/40 words to pass this.

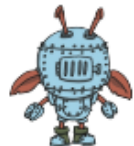
