We are situated on the A449 between Worcester and Kidderminster. There is ample parking at the local community centre accessed down Cow Lane which ensures that pupils have safe access to the school.

The school is a village First school and is part of the Droitwich pyramid. Pupils progress to middle schools in Droitwich or the primary system in Stourport or Worcester.

Wrap around care is also provided before and after school through PALs, who also run holiday clubs.

Sytchampton belongs to the Lloyd's Educational Foundation (a charitable trust) which means that the building and grounds are owned by The Lloyds Educational Foundation and is therefore classed as a voluntary

aided school.
