Secondary School

All In A Day

- Using everyday vocabulary and real world scenarios, speak in sentences, use familiar vocabulary and phrases, and show understanding of learning about time through simple writing.

This Is France

- Learn key vocabulary and phrases related to France and the capital city, Paris
- Learn specific vocabulary to describe France, in terms of its neighbours and the positions/distances of a variety of cities.
- Learn the French names for famous French landmarks, such as 'tour Eiffel' - the Eiffel Tower, Describe what people do when they visit Paris
- Famous French people and the names for the fields they were/are famous for

Let's Go Shopping

- Further develop understanding of basic grammar rules Use the verb 'faire' (to do)
- Develop confidence in discussing the colour of clothes, clothing items and how much something costs
- Practise what we have learnt using role play using the different verb conjugations.

Let's Visit a French Town

- New vocabulary and phrases to do with places in town, directions and numbers
- Read French Signs and find our way around a French town.
- Increase understanding of grammatical features and structures, as well as word classes.

All About Ourselves

- Apply previous knowledge of topic areas such as clothes and the body, developing vocabulary at the same time
- Describe own appearance
- Introduce some key grammatical features of French, such as the position of adjectives
- Have the opportunity to talk about emotions and health, increasing conversational skills

Family and Friends

- Apply previous skills and knowledge of topic areas such as animals, homes and family to extend conversation abilities
- Expand vocabulary and consolidate understanding of descriptive language, including subjective descriptions
- Learn how French adjectives must 'agree' with the noun they describe, in relation to both number and gender
- Find out more about possessive adjectives and explain a family network in detail

School Life

- Key vocabulary related to objects, subjects and prepositional language
- Maths lesson in French - names of 2D shapes
- How to ask and answer maths questions
- Learn questions and answers which would be used at school.

- Extend knowledge of talking about themselves
- Future tenses and ambitions

- Direction and movement
- Develop understanding of high-frequency verbs

All Around Town

- Introduce some of France's biggest cities
- Begin to find their way around by learning about places in a town
- Learn to give their address and count up to 100

Food Glorious Food

- Vocabulary for a range of food
- How to express likes and dislikes
- How to count and use plural nouns
- 'Le Chien très gourmand' [The very Greedy Dog]

Family and Friends

- Vocabulary, phrases and grammar structures to talk about family members.
- Learn how to identify different family members, say 'my', and use 'voici' to explain who's in a picture.
- Learn how to use possessive adjectives

Our School

- Vocabulary of school places and objects
- Combine learning to express preferences
- Listen to and understand topic vocabulary
- Demonstrate understanding with actions
- Write sentences where they convert le/la into un/une
- Answer questions using the topic vocabulary
- Discuss the objects in the classroom in French confidently

What's the Time?

- Tell the time in French: o'clock, half past, quarter past, quarter to
- Interpret and answer questions about timetables
